Calendar listing

The calendar listing is arguably the best-read feature in the paper. To get your information in print, you must first post it online at www.gvnews.com. Click on "Calendar" at the top, then follow the directions. This is free, but you'll need to create an account (you do not have to be a subscriber). Your item will appear online within 24 hours and also in print in the Get Out! features section. We don't list community garage sales; to place an ad for those, call the advertising department at 625-5511.

Five Things to Do

This popular feature is published in the Get Out! section of the Green Valley News on Wednesdays and items are chosen by the staff. They will have broad interest and the five selected items cover several topics, from great hikes to concerts to festivals. Think of it as a high-profile calendar item. Briefs

A brief is a higher-profile item that has a track record of drawing a crowd. News items usually go in the A-section; those that are more feature-oriented will be published in the Get Out! section. Politics
